Red Flags and Neurological Symptoms

Clinical emergencies can happen suddenly in palliative and end of life care. Without urgent medical attention, they can affect a patient's prognosis and quality of life.

- Recognise patients at risk of a palliative care emergency
- Recognition of the signs and symptoms including (Malignant Spinal Cord Compression, Malignant Superior Vena Cava Obstruction, severe haemorrhage, neutropenic sepsis, delirium, seizures)
- Treatment options and management
- How and when to refer for urgent treatment
