NHSE Levels (2025)	Who is it for?
S = Supportive	Health and Social Care professionals who would like to gain a core understanding and build their confidence in supporting individuals and their families in palliative and end of life care. E.g. healthcare assistants, social care support workers, care home managers, social workers
R/A = Registration & Assistive	Registered health care professionals who are band 4 and 5 (or equivalent), who want to enhance their knowledge and skills in palliative and end of life care. E.g. Registered nurses and nurse associates, allied healthcare professionals.
